BABY (0-6 MONTHS) – CURIOUS & LEARNING THE WORLD

Your baby Amazon is energetic and eager to explore! This stage is crucial for building trust, socialization, and motor skill development.

Toys: Soft chew toys, beginner foraging puzzles, lightweight foot toys

Activities: Hand-feeding, target training, sensory play with various textures

Enrichment: Soft rope perches, background music, supervised out-of-cage time

Mental Stimulation: Talking games, simple problem-solving toys, interactive play

JUVENILE (6 MONTHS – 5 YEARS) – PLAYFUL, ENERGETIC & TESTING BOUNDARIES

Young Amazons are active and love to explore, requiring constant mental and physical stimulation.

Toys: Challenging foraging puzzles, shreddable materials, climbing structures

Activities: Trick training, flight recall, interactive play like tug-of-war

Enrichment: Varied perches, outdoor exposure, rotating toys

Mental Stimulation: Puzzle feeders, learning new words, socialization with family

ADULT (5-35 YEARS) – INTELLIGENT, SOCIAL & ROUTINE-ORIENTED

Adult Amazons thrive on structure, social interaction, and mental challenges to prevent boredom.



Toys: Complex foraging puzzles, swings, independent play items

Activities: Advanced trick training, speech in context, dancing sessions

Enrichment: Rotating toys, multi-level cage setup, safe chew materials

Mental Stimulation: Treat hide-and-seek, supervised bird interactions, practical command training

SENIOR (35+ YEARS) – COMFORT-SEEKING & SLOWING DOWN

Aging Amazons require a comfortable environment, gentle activities, and continued mental engagement.

Toys: Softwood chews, simple foraging toys, fleece perches

Activities: Gentle stretching exercises, slow-paced training, quiet social time

Enrichment: Soft, easy-to-grip perches, lower perches for accessibility, warm cage setup

Mental Stimulation: Soft music, familiar words and songs, low-effort problem-solving toys
